

GUIDELINES FOR WMTA SCHOLARSHIPS

The following criteria shall be considered by the Scholarship Committee and judged according to the information submitted with the Scholarship Application. Applications submitted will be considered within the limitations of scholarship funds available and/or number of awards authorized.

The applicant must be a member of the Washington Municipal Treasurer's Association.

Scholarship applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee by the deadline reflected on the application.

The applicant and their supervisor must sign the application.

Scholarships **may** be limited to only one applicant from one municipality for any given year.

APT US&C Conference scholarships are first awarded for registration, then lodging and/or travel. (Maximum of \$750.00)

Northwest Treasurer's Institute scholarships are primarily awarded for tuition only (not room and board), however, additional funds may be awarded depending on need, circumstances and scholarship funds available in the current funding year as determined by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarships awarded will be sent directly to the Institute with the recipient receiving notification.
